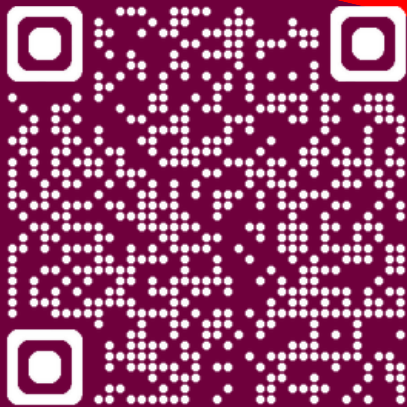

Rents down - your own home instead of high costs

Rents do not rise by themselves – **they are increased.**

In the last six years, rents have skyrocketed out of control. Families, students, trainees and pensioners – **all of us have to dig ever deeper into our pockets.** Enough is enough! Stop making profits off our backs! No sale of building land to greedy investors! Stop rent gouging!

We want more municipal housing, higher quotas for social housing and consistent action against vacancy and misuse of housing! For you, we want a **free tenancy law advisory service** – so that you can defend yourself.

Regensburg for everyone - for you and me

Our home is more than a UNESCO World Heritage Site. But to achieve that, it needs vibrant, social and ecological neighborhoods.

Sport, education, art and culture must be **available to all residents** of Regensburg – **regardless of their wallet size!** We want to expand the city pass offerings, create places to meet without any obligation to buy, and set up cultural and youth centers in all districts.

Accessibility should be taken into account in all building projects. Green areas should be available for joint gardening by neighbors, and social workers should be able to be present on the ground for the people in the neighborhood.

Our goal is clear: **a strong, solidaristic Regensburg that leaves no one behind!**

Good jobs – stop exploitation

Regensburg only works because **we keep this city running every day.**

City contracts should preferably go to regional businesses and strengthen crafts and small companies. Companies that cooperate with the city must be bound by collective agreements. Public money must not finance low wages.

For employees, we want to introduce a **multilingual labor law advisory service.** This will help prevent exploitation and minimum wage fraud and provide you with concrete support.

Climate – cool places instead of nothing but hot air

The **climate crisis also affects Regensburg:** sealed surfaces and too little shade increase the heat in summer. Floods are becoming more severe and more frequent.

This is life-threatening – in summer for senior citizens, children and everyone who has to work despite the heat, and the floods for everyone living along the rivers.

We want greened areas instead of stone deserts, well-developed flood protection and more drinking water points, as well as a free vegan option in municipal canteens.

Transport – getting there and back more easily

More and more people are using public transport. **But it needs to become simpler and more attractive.**

We want to expand public transport with a tram and bus lines that do not all have to go via the main station. Old railway tracks should be reactivated, and in the long term public transport should be free of charge.

Pedestrians and cyclists should have it easier. With adjusted traffic light phases, footpaths and cycle paths structurally separated from the road, and the expansion of cargo bike sharing, we want to make things easier for them.

All this - and much more

In our election program you will find many more demands. **But here we want to make you one more promise:**

As the Left, **we stand by your side.** Our policy is consistently social. That is why we cap our compensation in the city council.

Our city councillors will set up a **social fund** into which they will pay part of their allowances, which will benefit people in need.

We already offer a **social consultation in our office** every Friday from 4–6 p.m. – free of charge and for everyone. **No problem is too small!**
